## Protocol and What to Bring information for Delegates and International visitors

### WAIPAPA MARAE PROTOCOL

1. No shoes are to be worn inside the Wharenui (Meeting House)
2. No walking or jumping on mattresses
3. No sitting on pillows
4. No food / drink in or around the Wharenui (Meeting House)
5. No Smoking, Drugs, Alcohol
6. Keep noise to a minimum
7. Be respectful of each other at all times
8. Be a tidy kiwi (use rubbish bins)

### WHAT TO BRING

- Sleeping Bag / Duvet  
(A mattress, sheet, pillow and pillow case will be provided at the marae)
- Towel/s
- Toiletries
- Keep your luggage to one compact sized bag to save storage space in the sleeping area
